

Evergreen Garden Club Minutes January 12, 2016

Marva Zima welcomed new members Elaine Morse and Tahara Atim. Lindy Doty announced the birthdays for January: Diana Aldridge, Leslie Jordan, Kathy Lee, Jan Parks and Ginny Cerrillo.

Secretary's Report: Gloria Owens announced minutes were printed in the Wild Iris and asked if there were any corrections to the minutes. Hearing none, the minutes were approved as printed. A thank you card from EChO was read for 302 pounds of food donations they received. A special thanks to Susan Blake and Jane Wingquist.

Gloria presented a proposal to subscribe to Jacquie Lawson e-cards. The cost would be \$14.95 a year. She stated email reminders of garden tour, get well cards, meetings etc. could be sent via internet and save on postage. Only two members are without email addresses and they would receive hard copies. Following discussion the proposal was approved.

Treasurer's Report: Jane Wingquist reported our checking account balance is \$1,263. She stated we received \$33 from the craft sales at our December Christmas Holiday brunch. The savings account balance is \$11,816. She reported there was discussion at the board meeting regarding donating to charity. It was decided, by the board, not to consider donating at this time until after the Garden Tour.

Directory: Annell Hoy announced there will be a new addendum adding new members Elaine Morse and Tahara Atim to the directory next month.

Technical Support: Sophia Pardo announced Paul Luzetski will be taking over the Evergreen Garden Clubs Facebook page.

<u>Old Business:</u> It was announced that Kristen Seyboth had a baby boy on December 31, 2015 at 11:34 a.m.

Lindy Doty stated there were 45 persons present at our December meeting. She asked members for their input about the Christmas Brunch. The members stated it was the best party ever. They liked the arrangement of the tables, games, decorations and especially the songs. Jane Wingquist also reminded members next year to bring their check books or cash for the craft sales. Lindy said there was a program change for this month and the White House Garden talk will be scheduled in February. This month's program is "Five Different Gardens" by Kim Bone, professional gardener. **<u>Garden Tour:</u>** Lynn Dimmick, garden chair, requested the entire club help. It is a major fund raiser for the club slated for July 16, 2016. She stated there were 300 - 400 persons who attended last year. There will be pre-tours for the docents this year. Annell Hoy handed out three sign up sheets for various duties needed on tour. It was suggested publicity be put on Twitter, Facebook and Evergreen Neighbors and Friends. Public Gardens: Lynn Dimmick reported all gardens are good.

New Business:

Earth Day: Diana Aldridge agreed to chair Earth Day on April 23, 2016 developing morning/afternoon shifts, offering seed planting for kids and a drawing for a plant for adults.
